Buy Local funds sprout up for Comox Valley business

COURTENAY – What is on your grocery list this week? A family-owned Comox Valley business is hoping their organic sprouts and microgreens will be picked up by even more British Columbians after receiving funding from the B.C. government's Buy Local program.

Eatmore Sprouts & Greens Ltd. is receiving \$26,500 in Buy Local funds to promote their Vancouver Island-grown products through retailers, farmers markets and food-related community events. The business looks to continue their success by reaching out to new customers and increasing overall sales.

Carmen and Glenn Wakeling are the proud owners of Eatmore Sprouts & Greens Ltd. Their business is located on 1.5 hectares (3.75 acres) near Courtenay and employs 35 people. The organic sprouts (including alfalfa, deli, clover and broccoli) and greens are produced year round in a sustainable indoor growing facility and greenhouse buildings.

The Buy Local program has received \$6 million in B.C. government funding since 2012 to increase sales of locally grown and processed agrifood and seafood products within the province.

Building the local market for B.C. foods is a key commitment of government's Agrifoods Strategy, a component of the BC Jobs Plan, to lead the agrifoods sector growth into a \$14-billion-a-year industry by 2017.
